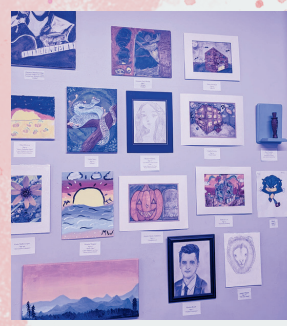

OUR APPROACH TO ARTS EDUCATION

At the FOA, we believe the greatest gift we can give our society is an artist who not only has a *broad knowledge* and *strong technique* in their talents, but also someone who can apply those skills in a spirit of *confidence, compassion, and a commitment to community service*.

DANCE can be a powerful tool for developing individual *character* and teaches our students to set goals, to *work effectively in teams*, to *creatively solve problems*, and embrace body awareness and agility.

THEATRE-done-well is the essence of *unity* and character building. Storytelling in *collaboration* and partnership with an audience teaches teamwork, sincerity, problem-solving, and *creativity*.

The beauty of creating an evolving piece of **VISUAL ART** can *inspire* and *uplift* the soul. Learning the techniques of visual art creates an appreciation for the detail of *beauty* and *growth*.

Learning and practicing **MUSIC** is an *all-encompassing skill* that one will never regret being part of - the bridge to *any* art forms across *any* age!

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

At the FOA, we ask that families and students...

- Treat all Foundation of Arts employees, students, and parents with respect
- Remain quiet in our lobby and waiting areas
- Keep cell phone conversations to a respectful volume and turn cell phone ringers down or off
- Quietly occupy/supervise children (both students and siblings) while waiting
- Place all bags under the benches so that others may use additional seating available to them
- Keep children away from classroom doors and the stairwell leading up to our dance loft while classes are in session
- Dispose of all trash before you leave the Arts Center/Forum Theatre
- Take your children outside (weather permitting) if they become disruptive
- Refrain from hosting or encouraging unkind or disrespectful conversations with other parents or patrons

The Foundation of Arts reserves the right to withdraw any class from our programming that does not meet the minimum enrollment requirements and to close classes that are at their maximum capacity.

No refunds will be processed for summer programming unless a student is injured with a note from their doctor. If a class does not meet the minimum enrollment requirements, we will happily work to remedy the situation by placing the student into another class or camp of equal value.

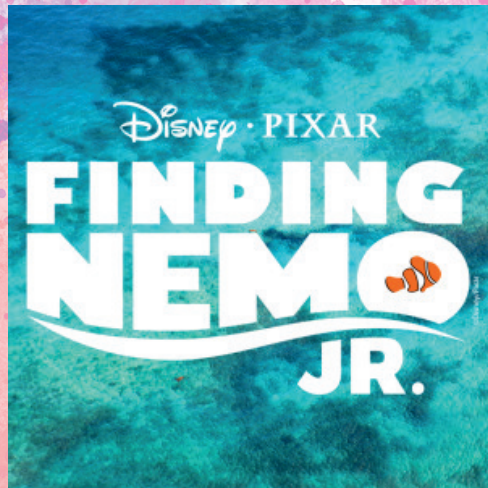
