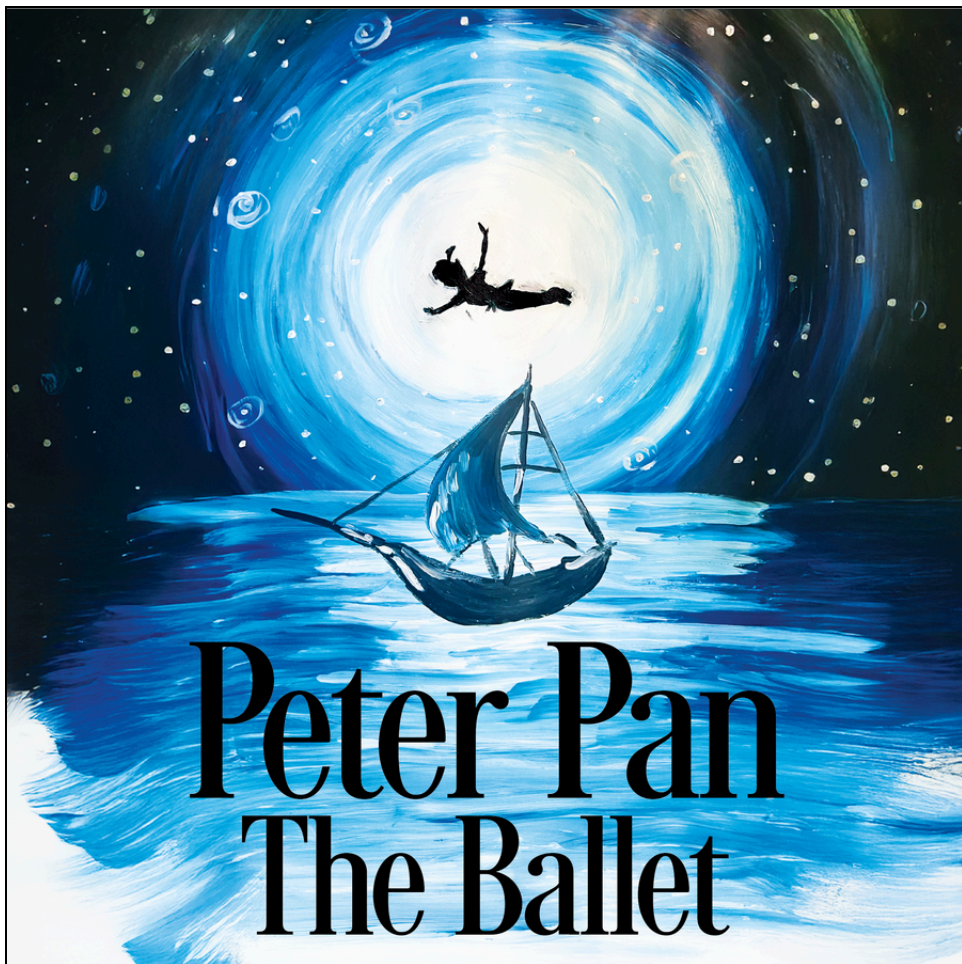

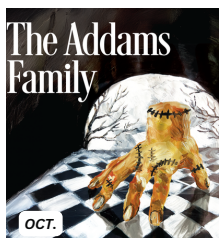

## LEEANN KING, DIRECTOR



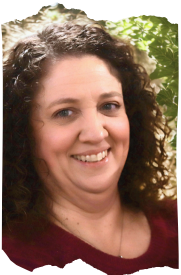
